Matter of: Laptops, Inc.-Reconsideration

File: B-270021.2

DECISION

Laptops, Inc. requests reconsideration of our October 26, 1995 dismissal of its protest of the award of a contract to Metropolitan Technical Services by the Department of the Air Force under solicitation No. F01600-95-R-0026. We dismissed the protest because other protests of the same procurement were pending before the General Services Administration Board of Contract Appeals (GSBCA) and under our Bid Protest Regulations, when a protest of a particular procurement is filed and is pending before the GSBCA, we generally will not consider any protest of that same procurement. Section 21.5(d), 60 Fed. Reg. 40,737, 40,742 (Aug. 10, 1995) (to be codified at 4 C.F.R. § 21.5(d)).

On reconsideration, Laptops states that our dismissal was erroneous, that the GSBCA was going to dismiss the protest, and that Laptops would furnish us a copy of the GSBCA dismissal. Laptops, however, provides no basis for establishing that our dismissal was erroneous, and it has never furnished a copy of any GSBCA dismissal.

The request for reconsideration is denied.
