MATTER OF: Control Power Systems, Inc.

DIGEST:

Upon request for reconsideration, prior decision dismissing one portion of protest as untimely and denying remainder is affirmed since protester does not advance any additional facts or legal arguments which show that earlier decision was erroneous.

Control Power Systems, Inc. (CPS) has requested reconsideration of our decision B-183603, September 16, 1975, 75-2 CPD 149, wherein this Office held its protest untimely in part and sustained the rejection of its bid as nonresponsive by the Department of Interior, Bureau of Reclamation.

Decisions of the Comptroller General are subject to revision upon reconsideration if a material mistake of fact or law is alleged and proven. Fischer Engineering and Maintenance Co., B-179193, November 11, 1974, 74-2 CPD 253; Nartron Corp., B-178224, B-179173, November 12, 1974, 74-2 CPD 257. In its request for reconsideration, however, the protester does not present any new factual information or indicate through argument or cited precedent any mistake of law, but rather indicates general disagreement with our prior decision.

Our decision of September 16, 1975, is therefore affirmed.
