

DIGEST:

Protest against rejection of proposal based on RFP specifications which have been amended is now moot and therefore this Office will not consider the protest.

Dr. Helmut Weiss has protested the rejection of his proposal under request for proposals (RFP) H00167-76-R-0507, issued by the Naval Ship Research and Development Center, Bethesda, Maryland. In response to the protest, the procuring activity rescinded its letter rejecting Dr. Weiss' proposal and revised both the specifications and evaluation criteria. Dr. Weiss has declined to protest the new specifications, but requests that his protest based on the rejection of his proposal under the original specifications be considered on the merits.

We are aware of no basis for acceding to this request. The rescission of the proposal rejection letter rendered the protest moot, and Dr. Weiss has explicitly declined to protest any subsequent action of the procuring activity. We are therefore closing our file on the matter.
