**MATTER OF: Convey-All, Inc.**

**DIGEST:**

Protest regarding solicitation which has been canceled by procuring agency is moot.

Convey-All, Inc. (CAI), protests the proposed award of a contract by the Naval Regional Procurement Office, Washington, D. C., under solicitation No. N00600-77-B-1394, a two-step formally advertised procurement.

The solicitation in question was for the furnishing of a pallet system at the Naval Air Terminal, Sigonella, Sicily. CAI protests its "rejection" under the solicitation and contends that the product offered by one of its competitors did not conform to the specifications. CAI, therefore, requests a resolicitation of the Navy's requirements.

We now have been advised that the solicitation has been canceled and that the requirements will be resolicited. Since the protest is therefore moot, we will take no further action thereon.

The protest is dismissed.
