MATTER OF: Fry Equipment Co., Inc.

**DIGEST:**

Whether equipment furnished complies with contract requirements is matter of contract administration for the contracting agency, not GAO.

Fry Equipment Co., Inc. (Fry), protests that the contracting officer will not accept certain valves which Fry has furnished to Artistic Plumbing Co. (Artistic) in connection with Artistic's performance of contract No. DADA03-80-C-0098.

Whether the supplied equipment is in compliance with the contract requirements is a matter of contract administration for the contracting agency and is not for consideration under our Bid Protest Procedures. See Lanier Business Products, Inc., B-196736, March 10, 1981, 81-1 CPD 186; Schmidt Engineering & Equipment Co., Ltd., B-198542, February 19, 1981, 81-1 CPD 108.

Accordingly, the protest is dismissed.
