DIGEST:

GAO does not review protests by Federal employees against agency determination under Office of Management and Budget Circular No. A-76 to contract for services rather than have them performed in-house.

Mr. Joseph Felix, on behalf of himself and other General Services Administration (GSA) mechanical employees, protests GSA's decision to contract out for mechanical maintenance at the Green/Byrne Complex in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, under solicitation No. GS-03-82-B-0064.

Our Office does not review protests by Federal employees against agency determinations under Office of Management and Budget Circular No. A-76 to contract for services rather than have them performed in-house.
