Matter of: Sprague & Henwood, Inc.

DIGEST

The General Accounting Office has no authority to review procurements by other than federal agencies, and also does not review complaints concerning the award of contracts under federal grants.

DECISION

Sprague & Henwood, Inc., complains about the rejection of its bid under invitation for bids No. 391-0486/GSP/86/031/PRQ-01, for diamond core drill bits. The solicitation was issued by the government of Pakistan, and the contract is to be funded by a grant from the Agency for International Development (AID).

We dismiss the matter. Our Office has no authority to review a procurement by other than a federal agency, see Environmental Tectonics Corp., 65 Comp. Gen. 584 (1986), 86-1 CPD ¶ 377, and, in any event, we no longer review complaints concerning the award of contracts under grants. Scott Huber Essick, B-220396, Dec. 10, 1985, 85-2 C.P.D.

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
