Matter of: Jose A. Del Valle

DECISION

Jose A. Del Valle protests the purchase of a property by a nonprofit organization from the Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD). Mr. Del Valle contends that the purchase is improper.

Under the Competition in Contracting Act of 1984, 31 U.S.C. §§ 3551 *et seq.* (1988), we are authorized to consider protests concerning contracts for the "procurement of property or services." 31 U.S.C. § 3551(1). Our regulations provide for consideration of protests involving sales of government property only if the federal agency awarding the contract agrees in writing to have us do so. See 4 C.F.R. § 21.11. Here, the federal agency involved has not done so. Under these circumstances, there is no basis for us to review the protest. See Columbia Communications Corp., B-236904, Sept. 18, 1989, 89-2 CPD ¶ 242.

The protest is dismissed.

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
