Matter of: Ogden Government Services Corporation

DECISION

Ogden Government Services Corporation protests the award of a contract to Betac Corporation under request for proposals No. DMA800-94-R-6000, issued by the Defense Mapping Agency (DMA) for systems engineering and evaluation support of the Department of Defense's Intelligence Systems Support Office. Ogden argues that DMA treated offerors unequally with respect to the solicitation's page and type-size limitations, and challenges the agency's conduct of discussions.

We dismiss the protests as academic.

Subsequent to the filing of these protests, Ogden and DMA agreed to terms for a resolution of the matter and are in the process of drafting a formal agreement. Ogden has withdrawn its protests, noting the parties' agreement that the protests may be reinstated in the event that either party fails to comply with any material term of the agreement. We find that this agreement renders the protests academic and, since it is not our practice to consider academic questions, the protest are dismissed. See East West Research, Inc.--Recon., B-233623.2, Apr. 14, 1989, 89-1 CPD ¶ 379.
