# Decision

**Matter of:** Ogden Government Services Corporation

**File:** B-265908

**Date:** September 5, 1995

## DECISION

Ogden Government Services Corporation protests the exclusion of its proposal from the competitive range by the Department of the Army under request for proposals No. DACA01-95-R-0093.

We dismiss the protest.

Ogden's proposal was rejected by letter of August 9, 1995. In a letter dated August 17, Ogden requested a debriefing. The agency advised Ogden that a debriefing will not be held until after contract award. Ogden protested its rejection to our Office on August 29, stating that it was improperly excluded, but without providing any further support for its allegations. Such an allegation by itself does not set forth a valid basis for protest.

In essence, we view the matter as premature because Ogden has not yet received a debriefing explaining the reasons for its proposal's exclusion from the competitive range. If, in the future, the agency provides Ogden with a debriefing or additional information that may properly form the basis for a valid bid protest, the protester may file with our Office at that time.
