Exquisito Services, Inc. protested the post-bid-opening cancellation of invitation for bids No. F41800-B-12059 for food service at Lackland Air Force Base, Texas and the subsequent sole-source award of a contract for the same requirement to Aleman Food Services, Inc. pursuant to the Small Business Administration section 8(a) program.
