Accomplishments of 18 Inspectors General

Dear Mr. Chairman:

You requested that we provide information about the resources and selected accomplishments of inspectors general (IG) at 18 federal departments and agencies, which are listed in enclosure 1. Specifically, you requested information for fiscal years 1992 through 1999 on (1) reported actual obligations, (2) reported actual number of full-time equivalent staff, (3) reported questioned costs, (4) reported funds to be put to better use, (5) reported investigative recoveries, and (6) reported number of reports issued.

We obtained the most recent information available from the Budget of the United States Government and obtained from the IGs the information provided in their semiannual reports. As agreed with your office, we did not verify the information presented in enclosure 2.

We requested comments on a draft of this letter from officials in the 18 IG offices. These officials generally agreed with the information in this letter.
