We have reviewed Fr. reported indebtedness, and in view of a recent decision of our Office, hamely, B-137605; dated April 2, 1959, copy herewith, no further collection action will be taken on that portion of his indebtedness which represents proper charges for packing and transporting his household goods from Florida to California in 1954. However, we are unable to saive collection of that portion of his indebtedness which represents charges for the shipment of personal baggage from California to Florida and return.
