Dear Mr. Secretary:

This relates to my letter to you of September 12, 1973.

Recognizing the ongoing Upward Mobility Project of the Department of Health, Education, and Welfard, and that a sharp tormination of this program would not be in the best interest of HUH or Federal City Collega, and in view of the fact that the District of Columbia is proposing legislation to obtain the necessary authority, we would not object to the continuation of contractual relations between the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare and the District of Columbia Federal City College to provide such caucational services pending an opportunity for legislative resolution.
