Dear Mr. Du Bey:

Pursuant to 4 C.F.R. Part 32, we have treated your correspondence with our Claims Group as a request for reconsideration of our Claims Group's disallowance of your claim. Enclosed is the comptroller General's decision of today concluding that there is no legal basis to allow the claim.

Your letter also refers to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552. As an agency responsible to Congress, GAO is not subject to the Freedom of Information Act. It is our policy, however, to make our records available to the public to the extent disclosure is consistent with our functions and responsibilities to the Congress and is not prohibited by law. We have issued regulations concerning the availability of GAO records to the public. We be 4 C.F.R. Part 81 (1980).
