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DIGEST:

Allegation that contractor is not performing in accordance with contract requirements, is matter of contract administration and not for resolution under Bid Protest Procedures.

Kornylak Corporation protests the award of contract No. N00228-79-R-3338 by the Naval Supply Center (NSC), Oakland, California to Transco Northeast, Inc. Kornylak contends that Transco is not performing in accordance with the specifications of the contract.

Whether the awardee is in fact performing in accordance with contract requirements is a matter of contract administration which is the function and responsibility of the procuring activity. Consequently, we do not consider such matters under our Bid Protest Procedures. <u>Precision Environments, Inc.</u>, B-198418, April 29, 1980, 80-1 CPD 306; Jacobs Transfer, Inc., B-200689, October 17, 1980, 80-2 CPD

The protest is dismissed.
