Dear Mr. Chairman:

On July 8, 1987, we issued a fact sheet (GAO/GGD-87-96FS) that provided information you requested during March 1987 on career/noncareer appointment trends in the executive branch and 27 executive agencies at the end of fiscal years 1980, 1983, and 1986. Pursuant to a request from your office, this fact sheet breaks down similar information for the Departments of Commerce, Education, Health and Human Services, the Interior, and Justice by their subunits.

We collected the requested information from reports and files generated by the Office of Personnel Management (OPM). Since the date of OPM's most recent information was March 31, 1987, we obtained the 1980 and 1983 data as of March 31 of those years as well. However, information on Schedule C employees was not available as of March 31 of 1980 or 1983. Instead, we collected the available Schedule C information as of February 21, 1980, and April 29, 1983. We did not verify the OPM data with the departments.

These employment trends varied among specific subunits in each of the five departments that we visited. Overall, four of the five departments had more Schedule C employees and SES noncareer appointees in 1987 than in 1980, and three departments had fewer SES career appointees. Also, central-type subunits, such as offices of the Secretary and Under Secretary, and administrative offices, tended to have more of these noncareer employees than other subunits in each department.

Appendix I shows the overall trends from 1980 to 1987 for the five departments through three tables which track the number of

- -- filled and vacant Executive Schedule positions;
- -- SES career, noncareer and limited term appointees, and SES vacancies; and

-- Schedule C employees.

Appendix II through appendix VI break out the information by subunits of each department.

The types of employees and positions to which each of these appendixes refer are described below:

- -- Executive Schedule employees are noncareer officials who are appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the President or department head, usually subject to Senate confirmation. Their positions are established by law, as identified in Title V, section 5311 of the U.S. Code.
- -- SES Career appointees have career status and are appointed under competitive procedures.
- -- SES noncareer appointees and limited term appointees serve at the pleasure of the appointing authority. Neither type of appointee has career status nor obtains their positions through competitive procedures. However, limited term appointees serve a nonrenewable defined tenure, of up to either 18 or 36 months, while the length of noncareer appointments is not limited.
- -- Schedule C employees serve in positions at the GS-15 level and below which are excepted from competitive appointment procedures because of their policymaking role, or their close, confidential working relationship with high-level political appointees. OPM must specifically authorize each Schedule C position based on an agency's request and justification. No limit on the number of Schedule C positions exists; however, when a Schedule C position is vacated, the OPM authorization is withdrawn.

OPM allocates SES positions to departments and agencies who then establish specific positions for their subunits from OPM's allocation. By law, the total number of SES and General Schedule (GS) 16, 17, and 18 positions may not exceed 10,777. Noncareer appointees may not fill more than 10 percent of all allocated positions or 25 percent in any department or agency (with certain exceptions). The number of limited term appointees may not exceed 5 percent of all allocated SES positions.

Because the SES allocation process does not directly involve subunits, it was not possible for us to determine, by subunit, the portion of allocated positions filled by noncareer appointees. Instead, appendix I shows the percentage of allocated and filled SES positions that noncareer appointees held in each department. Appendix II shows subunits in which the noncareer appointees were located.

As agreed with your office, we plan no further distribution of this fact sheet until 30 days after the date of issuance, unless you publicly announce its contents earlier.
