Dear Mr. Chairman:

In response to your request of August 11, 1988, this fact sheet provides information on costs of the Secretary of State's personal travel.

Specifically, you requested information on (1) the total cost to the government of such travel; (2) an itemized cost breakdown, including such categories as air transportation, ground transportation, lodging, per diem, salaries, overtime, and telephone expenses for (a) the Secretary, his family, and staff, (b) security personnel, and (c) communications personnel; and (3) the amount the Secretary reimbursed the government for such travel.

Information provided to us by the State Department shows that the total cost, excluding salaries, to the U.S. government of nonofficial trips taken by the Secretary from January 1986 through July 1988 was \$1,892,214. This consists primarily of the cost of military aircraft and the cost of having State Department personnel accompany the Secretary. The Secretary and others have reimbursed the government \$18,783 for these trips (see app. I). Reimbursements were based upon the economy air fare rate plus one dollar, according to State officials.

Appendix II provides a breakdown of costs into various categories and details those costs for each trip. According to State Department officials, detailed cost information for trips taken prior to 1986 is not readily available. Appendix III does, however, contain State Department data describing the purpose of all of the Secretary's trips that included at least some private component during the period July 1982 through July 1988.

Because of time limitations, we have not verified the overall accuracy of the data supplied by the State Department. We did, however, examine supporting documentation for some selected data and did not identify any significant discrepancies.

Unless you publicly announce its contents earlier, we plan no further distribution of this fact sheet until 30 days from its issue date.
