To the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives

On March 26, 1984, the President's eighth special message for fiscal year 1984 was submitted to the Congress pursuant to the Impoundment Control Act of 1974. The special message proposes three new deferrals of budget authority totalling \$42,632,000. Our report follows.

D84-59 Federal Aviation Administration Facilities, Engineering and Development, FAA Amount deferred: \$360,000 69X1303

According to the apportionment form for this account, the amount shown as total budgetary resources in this account (\$3,971,000) is incorrect; the correct figure is \$4,924,210.
