To the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives

On February 6, 1985, the President's fifth special message for fiscal year 1985 was submitted to the Congress pursuant to the Impoundment Control Act of 1974. The special message proposes 226 new rescissions totalling \$371,994,000. A copy of the President's listing of the proposed rescissions in the fifth special message is enclosed.

We have reviewed the fifth special message. Except as noted below, we have identified no additional information that would be useful to the Congress in its consideration of the President's proposals. Our report on those rescission proposals in the message which we believe require comment follows.

DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE

R85-18 World Agricultural Outlook Board Amount proposed for rescission: \$32,000 1252100

The most recently prepared apportionment schedule for this account reflects anticipated reimbursements of \$55,000 which were not included in the President's reported amount for "Other budgetary resources." The schedule reflects "Total budgetary resources" as being \$1,697,000, rather than \$1,642,000 as reported by the President.

R85-21 Office of International Cooperation and Development Scientific activities overseas Amount proposed for rescission: \$9,000 12X1404

The apportionment schedule for this account, dated February 7, 1985, reflects a balance brought forward on October 1 of \$1,316,000, which was not included in the President's reported amount for "Other budgetary resources." The schedule reflects "Total budgetary resources" of \$6,316,000, rather than \$5,000,000 as reported by the President.

DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE--CIVIL

R85-71 Corps of Engineers-Civil Construction, general Amount proposed for rescission: \$4,000,000 96X3122

The apportionment schedule for this account, dated January 15, 1985, indicates a total amount for "Other budgetary resources" of \$580,989,465, rather than \$560,989,465, as reported by the President. The schedule reflects total budgetary resources of \$1,470,989,465, rather than \$1,450,989,465 as reported by the President.

R85-75 Corps of Engineers--Civil Revolving fund Amount proposed for rescission: \$3,900,000 96X4902

The apportionment schedule dated January 25, 1985 reflects a transfer removing \$3,200,000 from this account which is not deleted from the reported amount for "Other budgetary resources" in the President's message. The schedule, therefore, reflects "Other budgetary resources" and "Total budgetary resources" of only \$71,693,829, rather than the reported amount of \$74,893,829 in the President's message.

DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY

R85-86 Energy Programs Naval petroleum and shale reserves Amount proposed for rescission: \$181,000 89X0219

The President's rescission message reflects "New budget authority" of \$156,874,000. The apportionment schedule dated January 24, 1985 indicates, however, that new budget authority of \$160,076,000 was provided for this program. The apportionment schedule reflects "Total budgetary resources" of \$294,688,078 rather than \$291,486,078, as reported by the President.

R85-89 Energy Programs Energy information administration Amount proposed for rescission: \$846,000 8950216

The apportionment schedule dated January 24, 1985, indicates that the proper appropriation symbol for this account is 8950216, rather than 89X0216 as reported by the President. The funds are only available during fiscal year 1985, rather than being no-year funds as identified in the President's message.

R85-90 Energy Programs Emergency preparedness Amount proposed for rescission: \$51,000 8950234

The apportionment schedule dated January 14, 1985, indicates that the proper appropriation symbol for this account is 8950234, rather than 89X0234 as reported by the President. The funds are only available during fiscal year 1985, rather than being no-year funds as identified in the President's message.

DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES

R85-120 Health Care Financing Administration Program management Amount proposed for rescission: \$1,540,000 7550511

The most recently prepared apportionment schedule reflects additional resources of \$2,029,100 in reimbursements and a total of \$1,129,979,000 in trust fund transfers which are not included in the President's reported amount for "Other budgetary resources." A total of \$21,432,000 is designated but not available pursuant to Public Law 98-473. The schedule reflects total budgetary resources of \$1,208,693,100, as opposed to \$98,147,000 as reported by the President.

R85-121 Human Development Services Amount proposed for rescission: \$1,334,000 7551636 75X1636

The apportionment schedule for account # 75X1636 reflects an additional \$835,973 in anticipated recoveries of prior year obligations. In account # 7551636, \$100,000 was designated as not available pursuant to Public Law 98-473. The schedules for these accounts reflect a total of \$1,998,702,387 in "Total budgetary resources" rather than the \$1,997,966,414 as reported by the President.

R85-124 Departmental Management General Departmental management Amount proposed for rescission: \$1,246,000 7550120

The apportionment schedule dated February 1, 1985 indicates a "Total budgetary resources" figure of only \$150,893,000, rather than \$153,747,000 as reported by the President. Agency officials advised us that this difference is due primarily to a reduction in the amount of anticipated reimbursements.

DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE

R85-155 Legal Activities Salaries and expenses, Community Relations Service Amount proposed for rescission: \$43,000 15X0500

According to a Justice Department official and the apportionment schedule for this account dated February 7, 1985, the proper appropriation symbol is 15X0500, rather than 1550500 as reported. Total budgetary resources should be \$41,237,967 rather than \$6,450,000 as reported by the President. OMB staff confirmed that the message is in error.

DEPARTMENT OF LABOR

Second Contractor

R85-163 Employment and Training Administration R85-163A Program administration Amount proposed for rescission: \$218,000 1650172

The apportionment schedule dated January 30, 1985 reflects additional budgetary resources of \$94,000 in reimbursements which were not included in the President's reported amount of "other budgetary resources". Total budgetary resources in this account are \$112,919,000, rather than \$112,825,000, as reported by the President.

ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY

R85-210 Salaries and Expenses Amount proposed for rescission: \$1,862,800 6850200

The apportionment schedule dated January 25, 1985 reflects an additional \$20,000,000 in anticipated reimbursements which are not reflected in the President's message. Accordingly, total budgetary resources are shown as \$676,275,000, rather than \$656,275,000 as reported by the President.

The rescissions proposed in the Fifth Special Message were submitted pursuant to section 2901 of The Deficit Reduction Act of 1984 (Public Law 98-369). This section in part authorizes the Director of the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) to draft legislation, if necessary, to achieve fiscal year 1985 savings expected to result from improved management.

Section 515 of the Treasury, Postal Service, and General Government Appropriations Act, for 1985, as enacted in Public Law 98-473, requires (with some exceptions) that, of the budget authority provided for fiscal 1985 that would otherwise be available for consulting services, management and professional services, and special studies and analyses, 10 percent shall be placed in reserve and not made available for obligation or expenditure. OMB has advised us that, since they consider the actions taken to comply with this provision congressionallyrequired withholdings, they do not intend to submit special messages which report these amounts as impoundments. We have no objection to this approach. The apportionment schedules affected by section 515 list the amount reserved as "not available pursuant to P. L. 98-473."

Based on the current legislative calendar, the 45-day period of continuous session during which the funds may be withheld pending congressional consideration of a rescission bill will end on April 24, 1985.
