To the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives

On July 24, 1991, the President submitted to the Congress his sixth special impoundment message for fiscal year 1991. The message reports one proposed rescission of budget authority and revises the amount of one deferral previously reported. We have reviewed the proposed rescission and the revised deferral and found them to be in accordance with the Impoundment Control Act, 2 U.S.C. § 681, et seq., as amended.

Enclosure I provides specific information with regard to the deferral which we believe will be useful to the Congress in its examination of the message. Enclosure II provides a list of the proposed rescission and deferral as reported by the President.
