■ What is WISDOM?


WISDOM (**W**Isconsin **D**ata for **O**rganizational **M**anagement) is a Data Warehouse that contains historical and enriched CARES data.

■ What is a Data Warehouse?

A Data Warehouse is a decision support database.

This type of database is:

- Subject Oriented (**groups of data**)
- Integrated (**groups are linked**)
- Non-Volatile (**less frequent updates**)
- Time Variant (**historical view**)

Transactional Database

■ Objective

- Support the business transaction and operation processes

■ Content

- Database reflects the situation at a specific point in time

■ Updates

- Continuously updated through the operational process



Optimized to
get data OUT

Decision Support Database

■ Objective

- Provide access to accurate, historical and enriched data

■ Content

- Database contains enriched historical data to figure out trends, build forecasts and facilitate decision making

■ Updates

- Updated at preset time intervals (daily, weekly or monthly)
