Dear Senator Anderson:

We have made a review for the settlement of the accounts of certifying officers of the United States Territorial Expansion Memorial Commission through fiscal year 1969. Our review was made pursuant to the Budget and Accounting Act, 1921 (31 U.S.C. 53), and the Accounting and Auditing Act of 1950 (31 U.S.C. 67).

We found the procedures for processing cash receipts and disbursements in use by the Division of Finance, National Park Service, which maintains the Commission's accounts and records, to be generally satisfactory.
