Dear Captain Gregory:

As part of our continuous evaluation of the Navy's financial management system, we centrally audit selected transactions in the disbursing officers' accounts. Your disbursing efficer's accounts were selected for such an audit. We examined 185 military pay records closed June 30, 1972, and 347 travel and miscellaneous vouchers paid in August 1972. We found 50 errors -- 47 monetary and three leave accounting. These are summarized in the appendix.

Neither the errors nor the error rate were significant for the military pay transactions we examined. Now-ever, we did find some problems in travel payments. The most common types of travel errors involve:

- -- Pailure to make proper deductions for meals.
- -- Use of incorrect per dies rates.
- -- Failure to pay por diem for travel between stations.
- -- Use of incorrect distances to compute travel allevances.

Because we could not determine causes of these errors with the limited information at the Mavy Pinance Center, Cleveland, we visited your station in December 1972. Our

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inquiries and discussions with you and your disbursing office personnel disclosed several causes:

- -- Revisions to travel regulations were overlooked.
- -- The current Official Table of Distances was not received on time.
- -- Clerks made mistakes when preparing some of the vouchers.
- -- Supervisory reviews were inadequate.

Your disbursing officer advised us he would try to miniaize errors in travel payments by, (1) holding periodic refresher courses on travel regulations: (2) disseminating information pertaining to changes in travel entitlements; and (3) strengthening supervisory and internal reviews. These measures should keep to a minimum the number of improper payments and improve your disbursing operation.

Since we discussed our findings with you during our visit, we are not requesting any additional response from you. For information purposes we have enclosed copies of informal inquiries as examples of the more significant errors we found.

We appreciate the cooperation and assistance provided our auditors during this review. Please let us know if you have any questions or need additional information.
