Dear Sir:

In evaluating the Navy's financial management system, we test financial transactions in disbursing officers' accounts. In sampling the U.S.S. FULTON accounts for the 6 months ended June 30, 1972, we found some crew members were over or underpaid and leave balances were inaccurate because of errors in vouchers and military pay records. The errors are summarized in the appendix.

Voucher errors were predominant and indicate a need for more proficiency and supervisory attention in preparing and paying travel claims. The most common types of errors involved:

- -- payments of mileage and per diem when not entitled.
- -- incorrect deductions for meals and quarters,
- -- wrong per diem rates, and
- -- incorrect distances and terminal points.

We were unable to pinpoint responsibility or determine error causes since our review was limited to records at the Navy Finance Center, Cleveland. However, we believe travel errors could be substantially reduced if disbursing personnel become more familiar

with the Joint Travel Regulations. The other errors are the types that can be minimized by adequate verification and supervisory reviews.

We are bringing this information to your attention so that you can take action to preclude future errors. To assist you, we are enclosing information copies of our informal inquiries. We would appreciate your comments on the causes and actions taken. Please let us know if you need additional information.
