On December 2, 1980, the President's second special message for ~~fiscal year 1981~~ was transmitted to the Congress pursuant to the Impoundment Control Act of 1974. The special message proposed four new deferrals of budget authority totaling \$2,770.8 million and revisions to three previously transmitted deferrals increasing the amount deferred by \$846.2 million as follows:

On December 3, 1980, OMB released \$299.45 million of the proposed deferral for the following reasons:

--El Salvador	\$.5 million
--Korea	\$ 5.45 million
--Turkey	\$ 17.5 million
	<u>\$299.45 million</u>

Due to these releases, the amount deferred in D81-23 should be \$359.8 million, rather than \$659.25 million.

On December 3, 1980, OMB released \$595 million of the proposed deferral as follows:

On December 12 and 17, OMB subsequently released additional amounts totaling \$95.88 million as follows:

--South Africa	\$24.3	million
--Portugal	\$20.0	million
--Jordan	\$ 3.38	million
--New East Regional Program	\$ 1.2	million
--Liberia	\$ 7.0	million
--Jamaica	<u>\$40.0</u>	million
	\$95.88	million

Due to these releases totaling \$690.88 million, the amount deferred in D81-24 should be \$1,293.62 million, rather than \$1,984.5 million.


