## DECISION

Access Logic, Inc. protests the exclusion of its proposal from the competitive range under solicitation No. F23606-95-R-0002, issued by the Department of the Air Force.

We dismiss the protest.

The Air Force rejected Access Logic's proposal by letter of December 5, 1995, stating that the proposal failed to demonstrate a complete understanding of the requirements and would require a total proposal rewrite, and that upon written request a debriefing would be provided. Access Logic protested its proposal's rejection to our Office on December 7, stating that the proposal "included the majority of the proposal requirements" and that the "missing information was extremely minimal and would not [have] required a 'total rewrite' of its proposal to achieve compliance." Access, however, has not provided any factual information, documentation, or evidence to support its allegations. Such a submission does not set forth a valid basis for protest.

It appears that the absence of detail from the protest is due to the fact that Access Logic has not yet requested or received a debriefing explaining the reasons for its proposal's exclusion from the competitive range. If, in the future, the agency provides Access Logic with a debriefing or additional information that may properly form the basis for a valid bid protest, the protester may file with our Office at that time.

The protest is dismissed.
