[Protest of Procurement Involving Neither a Federal Agency Nor Federal Grantee]

DIGEST:

Procurement by Copper Valley Electrical Association Inc. using funds borrowed from Rural Electrification Administration is neither Federal procurement nor procurement involving Federal grant funds and therefore not for GAO review.

AGC 00270
Doyon/Ghemm/McWil Inc., a joint venture (D/G/M), protests the actions taken by the Copper Valley *DLG 02549* Electrical Association Inc. (Copper Valley) under Rural Electrification Administration (REA) Alaska 18U9 project.

We have been advised that the project is not an REA procurement and that the funds involved are those of Copper Valley, obtained through a loan from and repayable to REA.

Since the procurement involves neither a procurement by or for an agency of the Federal Government, nor a procurement by a Federal grantee, our Office will not consider the matter. Donovan Construction Company, B-191721, May 12, 1978, 78-1 CPD 371, and cases cited therein.

Therefore, the protest is dismissed.
