DIGEST:

Request for review of proposed award under grant solicitation is dismissed where material issues are before court of competent jurisdiction which has not expressed interest in receiving GAO's views.

M.D. Taddie and Company, Inc. (Taddie), has asked that our Office review the proposed award of a contract by the Township of Augusta, Michigan, to the Morrison \ \(\lambda 652)^7

Company for a water main ortanged. Company for a water main extension project which is to be financed by loan and grant funds from the Farmers Home Administration.

Taddie essentially contends that it is the low bidder for the project despite a minor mathematical error in its bid which allegedly may be waived, and that contrary to the award provisions of the solicitation the Township Board has voted to award the contract to the second low bidder.

Prior to filing its complaint with our Office, According to the proposed award to the months of the months are the months and the months are Taddie protested the proposed award to the Township also filed suit in the Circuit Court for the County of Washtenaw, Michigan (M.D. Taddie for the County of Taddie for the Washtenaw, Michigan (M.D. Taddie & Company, Inc. v. Township of Augusta, File No. 80-19407-CZ), seeking to set aside the Township's decision and requiring that award be made to Taddie. The issues raised in Taddie's suit are identical to those presented in the firm's complaint before us.

Under the circumstances, we decline to consider this complaint. It is our policy not to review matters where the material issues involved are before a court

of competent jurisdiction and the court has not expressed an interest in receiving our views. Schiavone Construction Co., Inc., B-191112, February 22, 1978, 78-1 CPD 151; Sovereign Construction Company, Ltd.; City of Philadelphia, B-185874, March 8, 1977, 77-1 CPD 168.

The complaint is dismissed.
