DIGEST:

Protest of procurement for nonappropriated fund activity is dismissed as GAO has no authority to render bid protest decision concerning expenditure of nonappropriated funds.

Security Assistance Forces & Equipment OHG (SAFE) protests a procurement by the Department of the Army under solicitation PAENAOFIR0018/0001 for smoke detectors for use in guest house facilities in Bad Kreuznach, Germany.

The Army reports that this procurement is being conducted for a nonappropriated fund activity, the Bad Kreuznach Transit Billet Fund. This Office has no authority to render a decision involving nonappropriated funds. Suburban Industrial Maintenance Company, B-198795, July 17, 1980, 80-2 CPD 40; Ms. Geneva Osborne, B-188004, January 7, 1977, 77-1 CPD 15.

The protest is dismissed.
