**DIGEST:**

Whether Federal Supply Schedule contractor's products meet specification requirements during performance of contract is a matter of contract administration which GAO will not consider.

G.R.P. Farquhar protests that Vestal Laboratories, Division of Chemed Corporation, which was awarded a Federal Supply Schedule contract by the General Services Administration under solicitation No. 7PF-52426/S5/7FC, is not providing chemical products which conform to the contract requirements.

Whether a Federal Supply Schedule contractor's products meet specification requirements during performance of the contract is a matter of contract administration for resolution by the contracting agency and will not be considered by this Office. Mosler Safe Company, B-213864, February 2, 1984, 84-1 C.P.D. ¶ 144.

The protest is dismissed.
