MATTER OF: TeQcom, Inc.

DIGEST:

Allegation that agency is failing to conduct a market survey prior to the exercise of an option is academic where agency is undertaking the survey.

TeQcom, Inc. has filed a protest in which TeQcom alleges that the Army is exercising an option under contract No. DAAB07-84-D-0005 without conducting a market survey. (This contract was the subject of a prior protest, TeQcom, Inc., B-212425, et al., Apr. 24, 1984, 84-1 CPD 467.) We have now received a letter from the Army, and have confirmed by telephone call to TeQcom, that the agency is conducting a survey by requesting quotations from vendors, including TeQcom. In these circumstances, TeQcom's protest is academic.

The protest is dismissed.
