## Decision

**Matter of:** NEI Syncrolift, Inc.--Reconsideration

**File:** B-252208.2

**Date:** June 29, 1993

### DECISION

NEI Syncrolift, Inc. requests reconsideration of our decision in Bardex Corp., B-252208, June 14, 1993, 93-1 CPD ¶ \_\_\_\_ in which we sustained the protest of Bardex Corporation under solicitation No. N00600-92-R-3786 issued by the Department of the Navy.

We deny the request for reconsideration because the request is made by a party who was aware of the original bid protest, but chose not to participate in that prior protest in any way.

Under our Regulations, an interested party who was aware of a protest, but chose not to participate in it, is not entitled to request reconsideration. 4 C.F.R. § 21.12(a). Where, as here, there is no showing that the nonparticipating party was unaware of the prior protest, we will not consider a request for reconsideration from that party. See generally Electrographic Corp.--Request for Recon., B-225517.2, June 8, 1987, 87-1 CPD ¶ 578.

The request for reconsideration is denied.
