Matter of: Laro Services Systems, Inc.

DECISION

Laro Services Systems, Inc. protests that the General Services Administration may improperly reject its offer under a go/no go experience provision contained in solicitation No. GS-02P-93-CTC-0088.

The protest is dismissed as premature.

GSA advises that Laro's offer is currently being evaluated for compliance and no decision has been made as to whether or not Laro's proposal is acceptable. Protests that merely anticipate improper agency action are speculative and premature. See General Elec. Canada, Inc., B-230584, June 1, 1988, 88-1 CPD ¶ 512. Consequently, there is no basis for us to consider the protester's claim at this time. If, in the future, the agency takes concrete action that may properly form the basis for a valid bid protest, the protester may file with our Office at that time.
