Matter of: Renic Government Systems, Inc.

File: B-259372

DECISION

Renic Government Systems, Inc. protests the rejection of its offer submitted in response to request for proposals (RFP) DU204-R-94-0068, issued by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), for real estate sales closing services in the state of Georgia, on the basis that the offer was delivered late.

HUD advises that under 24 C.F.R. Part 24 (1994), it has restricted Renic's participation in HUD programs, including procurements. This restriction, referred to as a Limited Denial of Participation (LDP), took effect on October 26, 1994, and applies for a period of twelve months. Since Renic is not eligible for contract award while it is subject to this restriction, it is not an interested party entitled to maintain a protest. See 4 C.F.R. § 21.0(a).

Accordingly, the protest is dismissed.
