We refer to your letter dated April 12, 1988, written jointly with the Honorable Richard G. Lugar, on behalf of Mr. R. Lee Johnson, president of Comphotronics, Inc. On June 7, 1988, the Government Printing Office (GPO) filed a report with our Office with regard to the protest of Comphotronics, Inc., under solicitation No. 3518-S.
