

Gentlemen:

This refers to your August 14, 1987, request that we reconsider our August 7 dismissal of your bid protest concerning Department of the Army solicitation No. DAEA18-87-B-0086 for an intrusion detection system at Fort Huachuca, Arizona. We dismissed the protest because the Army had indicated that it had amended the solicitation so as to eliminate the deficiencies you alleged. In requesting reconsideration, you asserted that the solicitation amendment in fact did not address all of your problems.

In its September 14 report on your request, the Army indicates that it has further amended the solicitation so as to clarify the requirements for the detection system and to address your remaining concerns. Accordingly, your request for reconsideration of your protest is academic, and we are closing our file on the matter.
