
Dear Mr. Bennett:

We refer to your letter to our Office dated July 15, 1987. You asked that we respond to you concerning an appeal filed by the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers on June 9, 1987, regarding a solicitation issued by the Naval Air Station, Jacksonville, Florida. Your correspondence to our Office included a letter from your constituent, Mr. [redacted], concerning this matter.

We have researched our records and are unable to locate any bid protest filed in our Office by the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers. On August 3rd, we discussed this matter with a member of your staff and learned that the June 9th appeal was filed with the Department of the Navy rather than with our Office.
