By letter dated September 12, 1986, you asked to be advised what course of action this Office would pursue with regard to the above-referenced contracts. Robert Buck and Charles Mills, individually and as owners of the Delta Summit Corporation, should not be debarred from further contracts.

We have reviewed the file and ancillary case submissions from you and cognizant officials of the Richland Operations Office, U.S. Department of Energy, and the Assistant Administrator, Employment Standards Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, and find no reason to object to disbursement of the funds on deposit with our Claims Group, \$5,001.63, in accordance with established procedures.
