This is in response to your letter to the Comptroller General, dated December 6, 1985, concerning alleged Davis-Bacon Act violations by Mr. Yon C. Shim and his Company, C & S Maintenance, which was a subcontractor on Contract No. N62474-83-C-6615. Your file reference is CA-85-439.

In your letter you informed us that the prime contractor on the foregoing contract (Two and Three Corporation) has requested a hearing pursuant to 5 C.F.R. § 5.11(b). From subsequent contact with your Department, we understand that it may be some time before that hearing takes place.

Accordingly, we are going to close our file on the matter without further action at the present time. When the hearing on the prime contractor is completed, we request that you forward the appropriate records to our Office and we will consider your Department's recommendations as to both the prime contractor and the subcontractor at that time.
