This is in response to your September 23, 1986, letter to our Office requesting reimbursement for unanticipated increased state tax liability in connection with several contracts Monaco is performing for the Small Business Administration.

A contractor's remedy for seeking increased payment under contracts with the federal government is the contract's disputes procedure and the Contract Disputes Act of 1978, 41 U.S.C. § 601-613 (1982), which establishes procedures for resolving such claims.

This matter therefore is outside the purview of our Office.
