

By letter dated June 14, 1985, you submitted to us the above-referenced case involving violations of the Davis-Bacon Act, 40 U.S.C. §§ 276A to 276a-5 (1982). You indicate that the Department of Labor does not recommend that Dive Scan, Inc., the subcontractor actually committing the violations, be placed on the ineligible bidders list. We agree that Dive Scan, Inc., should not be placed on that list.

Since it appears that there is no dispute in this case, the funds on deposit with our Claims Group, \$22,871.64, will be disbursed to the wage claimants in accordance with established procedures.
