Gentlemen:

This responds to your request for reconsideration of our decision in Denver X-Ray Instruments, Inc., B-220743, Oct. 18, 1985, 85-2 C.P.D. ¶ 429, in which we dismissed your protest of the award of a contract under request for proposals (RFP) No. F42650-85-R-3415, issued by Ogden Air Logistics Center, Hill Air Force Base, Utah.

We have been informally advised by the contracting agency that the contract awarded under the subject RFP has been terminated for the convenience of the government. The agency has also advised us that because the initial solicitation specifications were overly restrictive of competition, the requirement will be resolicited under specifications revised to reflect the agency's minimum needs.

Since the contract awarded under the original solicitation has been terminated and the requirement is to be recompeted under a new solicitation, your protest of the award under the original solicitation is academic and, therefore, will not be reconsidered.
