Heference is made to your letter of November 22, 1950, with which you returned check in the amount of \$24.18 which had been tendered to you in full payment of light bills totalling \$204.96 for service to the United States District Engineer under contract No. W-Ob-225(AA-VI)-1041 after deducting the sum of \$180.76 due the Government from your Department under contract No. W-Ob-353-eng-1888.

This Office has recently been informally advised by the Department of Justice that a settlement of the cases of City of Los Angeles v. The United States, numbered 19006 and 7kl3-H in the United States. District Court for the Southern District of California, Central Division, has been agreed upon with counsel for the city of Los Angeles. Presumably such settlement will either clarify or dispose of the matters in dispute between your Department and this Office and the Department of Justice has been asked to furnish the details of the said settlement as soon as it has been effected. Upon receipt of this information the matter here in question will be reconsidered in the light thereof and you will be advised of the action taken.
