We have received a letter from Mr. Paul A. Stone, Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary for Grants and Procurement Management, Department of Health, Education, and Welfare (HEW). The letter was dated December 31, 1975, and a copy was furnished you. We have by letter of today responded to Mr. Stone and have indicated serious concern with the action of HEW in exercising the purchase option in the Delta Data contract and failing to inform us or any of the interested parties of this fact prior to the issuance of our decision and in continuing to purchase Delta Data units on the basis of an unreasonable interpretation of our decision's recommendation.

We have, therefore, requested Mr. Stone to furnish us with additional details relating to the actions of HEW with regard to certain of these matters.
