DIGEST:

GAO is precluded from rendering authoritative decision on protest filed against procurement condition on behalf of nonappropriated fund activity since so, white of such activities do not fall within account settlement authority of 31 U.S.C. \$5 71 and 74 (1970) upon which bid protest jurisdiction is based.

Hs. Geneva Osborne has protested the award of Contract No. DAADO5-76-C-KO86 to another bidder by the Procurement Division, Aberdeen Proving Ground.

This contract is for a barber shop concession in the MCO Club, a nonappropriated fund activity. With regard to procurements conducted by or on behalf of nonsppropriated fund activities, this Office has no authority to render authoritative decisions. ACS Construction Company, Inc., 5-183034, April 18, 1975, 75-1 CPD 238. Our bid protest jurisdiction is based on our authority to adjust and settle accounts and to certify balsnees in the accounts of accountable officers under 31 U.S.C. 71, 74 (1970). Where we do not have such settlement authority, we have declined to consider protests on the grounds that we are precluded from rendering authoritative decisions on these matters. Equitable Trust Bank, B-181469, July 9, 1974, 74-2 CPD 14.

Since:we do not have settlement authority over nonappropriated fund activities, this Office is unable to render an authoritative decision on the protest.
