Procurement by Government of Equpt , using funds borrowed from agency for International Development, is neither Federal procurement nor procurement involving Federal grant funds and is not, therefore, subject to GAO review.

DLG01487 Pettibone Corporation (Pettibone) protests the actions at bid opening of the Alexandria Port DLG Authority, Alexandria, Arab Republic of Eqypt, 01489 in connection with invitation for bids (IFB) No. 78/04. The procurement is being conducted by the Government of Egypt using funds borrowed from and repayable with interest to the Agency AGC 00097 for International Development (AID Loan No. 263-K-031). Pettibone alleges that one of the bidders, Clark Manufacturing Company, should be declared nonresponsive for its failure to sign the bid/award/ purchase agreement form as required by the solicitation.

As the protested procurement involves neither a procurement by or for an agency of the Federal Government, nor a procurement by a Federal grantee, **CAO** our Office will not consider the protest on the merits. See Allis-Chalmers Corporation, <u>B-188514</u>, <u>April 5, 1977</u>, 77-1 CPD 235; <u>Bethlehem Steel Export</u> Corporation, B-189803, August 22, 1977, 77-2 CPD 139.

The protest is dismissed.
