Subject: Update on Federal Matching and Maintenance of Effort Requirements for California (GGD-80-63)

In a February 27, 1980, letter, you and 12 other members of the California Congressional delegation requested an updated version of the table on matching and maintenance of Federal Assistance To California Be Affected By Proposition 13?" (GGD-78-101 Arg. 10 1070) 13?" (GGD-78-101, Aug. 10, 1978). Your letter indicated the request was being made because of the delegation's concern about the effect of Proposition 9 on the State's future ability to meet matching and maintenance of effort requirements for many Federal grant programs. Proposition 9 is a ballot initiative scheduled for June 3, 1980, which, if passed, would cut the California State income tax by 50 percent. As requested, we are also providing information on the amount of Federal funds which flow into California under large programs with matching and maintenance of effort requirements.

We did not, and cannot, determine Proposition 9's effect 10 on Federal funds to California because Federal funding is dependent on the actions of relatively independent actors. How the State and its local governments allocate anticipated budget cuts will determine whether Federal matching and maintenance of effort requirements are met. Furthermore, the decisions of Federal agencies regarding waivers of program requirements will affect the amount of Federal funds received.

We identified 52 Federal grant programs available to California that (1) had national funding in excess of \$100 million in fiscal year 1980 and (2) had matching and/or maintenance of effort requirements. The enclosed table lists these programs. We excluded Federal grant programs

primarily available for schools of higher education, for research institutions, and for direct payments to individuals where State and local cost sharing is not federally mandated. Of the 52 programs identified, 36 have non-Federal matching requirements, and 38 have maintenance of effort requirements. The fiscal year 1980 Federal funding level for these programs in California is estimated at \$7.92 billion. The total fiscal year 1979 outlay under these programs was \$7.88 billion and represented approximately 85 percent of California's total Federal grant funds.

Forty-seven programs included in the enclosed table also appeared in our previous report. Of these 47 common programs, 19 had changes in their matching and/or maintenance of effort requirements. These changes generally involved reductions in non-Federal matching shares and more flexible maintenance of effort requirements. In addition, five programs were deleted from the updated table because they did not meet the inclusion criteria, and five new programs were added.

As agreed with your office, this report is addressed to you on behalf of the other members of the delegation who made the request. We are sending a copy to the other members. Should you or other members of the delegation wish to discuss the report, we would be happy to do so. As arranged with your office, unless you or other members requesting this report announce its contents earlier, we plan no further distribution until 10 days from the date of the report. At that time we will make copies available to others on request.
