

Dear Mr. Gradison:

This fact sheet responds to your July 15, 1986, request for information on (1) expiration dates for grant-in-aid programs that distribute funds to states and localities through the use of formulas and (2) House and Senate authorizing committees for these programs.

The information on expiration dates is part of a larger ongoing GAO study to describe and catalog federal grant formulas, which will be available in several months. The information on committee jurisdiction was obtained from GAO's Legislative, Authorization, Programs and Budgeting Information System, which was last updated in 1982. This was the most current information available within the time frame of your request.

In our ongoing formula grant study, we surveyed program managers and staff familiar with 142 formula grants to develop information on how the formulas work. The program managers also provided the information on dollars allocated to states and localities and on program expiration dates.

The baseline for our survey, and the information contained in this fact sheet, is fiscal year 1984. New programs established after fiscal year 1984 have not been included, but we have updated the authorization dates for programs that expired in fiscal year 1985.

The following table summarizes, for the formula grant programs detailed in the fact sheet, their expiration dates and the total dollars distributed to states and localities through them. The five programs shown for fiscal year 1985 have expired and have not been reauthorized. Fifty of the programs are scheduled for reauthorization during fiscal year 1986, and another 44 have no specific reauthorization dates.

Regarding the authorizing committees, most of the formula grants—based on total dollars distributed in fiscal year 1984—are concentrated in three committees in the House and Senate. The three House committees are Ways and Means (\$31.4 billion), Education and Labor (\$22.4 billion), and Public Works and Transportation (\$16.9 billion). The three Senate committees are Finance (\$38.3 billion), Labor and Human Resources (\$15.8 billion), and Environment and Public Works (\$14.5 billion).

#### INVENTORY OF FORMULA GRANT PROGRAMS IN FY 1984,

#### BY AUTHORIZATION EXPIRATION DATE

Table 1 details the authorization expiration dates for 142 formula grant programs used in fiscal year 1984 to distribute aid to states and localities. These dates were provided by agency officials as part of our broader study of formula grants used in that year. Also using information from agency officials, we updated the reauthorization dates for those programs that expired in fiscal year 1985.

The 142 formulas in the following tables are identified by the five-digit number assigned them in the Catalog for Federal Domestic Assistance (CFDA), which contains a description of all federal assistance programs. The first two digits describe the department or agency responsible for administering the program, and the last three digits are used as a descriptor for each program within that agency. For example, "10.550" represents the Department of Agriculture's (10) food distribution program (550). Where separate formulas had the same CFDA number, we report them separately, identifying them with an appended letter, e.g., 10.550A. The following two-digit codes identify the 16 departments and agencies in our study:
