The President's eighth special message concerning impoundments for fiscal year 1977 was received.

Findings/Conclusions: Rescission of the Small Business Administration's Business Loan and Investment Fund proposal was withdrawn. Revisions were made to three previously reported deferrals: military construction in the Department of Defense (DOD); military conservation and military reservations in the DOD; and Federal Aviation Administration facilities and equipment (airport and airway trust fund) in the Department of Transportation. On March 9, 1977, we received copies of the President's eighth special message for fiscal year 1977 that was transmitted to the Congress pursuant to the Impoundment Control Act of 1974. The special message withdrew one rescission proposal and contained three revisions to previously reported deferrals as follows:
